Prayers of forgiveness

So let us turn away from sin and turn to Christ,

Young people lead the prayers of forgiveness

After they had eaten, he took the cup of wine,
gave thanks, and shared it with his disciples, saying:
'This is my blood, poured out for you and for many,
for the forgiveness of sins.'

So Father, with this bread and this cup
we celebrate his love, his death, his risen life.
As you feed us with these gifts,
send your Holy Spirit,
and change us more and more
to be like Jesus our Saviour.

All say: How do we follow Jesus Christ?

Children: *Listen, and we will hear.*

Help us, Father, to love one another,
as we look forward to that day
when suffering is ended,
and all creation is gathered in your loving arms.

And now with Stephen and all your saints we give you thanks,
because you anointed Jesus Christ,
